

## Football Venue Entry Process

**Everyone attending the football on the Sunday, students, teachers and spectators, must register in advance. Entrance will not be permitted without doing so.**

All matches will be played at St Georges Park, Sheffield Graves.

The state-of-the-art multi-pitch facility is the first of 150 hubs planned as part of the FA's 'Parklife' project, which aims to transform grassroots football facilities across 30 English cities by 2020.

The hubs will serve as a focal point for grassroots football activity in the local area and offer greater access to player and coach development opportunities.

The pilot facilities have been funded by the FA, Sheffield City Council and the Department for Culture Media and Sport (DCMS) via Sport England. The Premier League has also committed funding to support the rollout of future hubs.
